RE: Notice of Temporary State Waste Discharge Permit No. ST-8104 for the Liquafaction Corporation

Your application for a State Waste Discharge Permit for the Liquafaction Corporation in Moses Lake was received by this office on June 6, 2007 and was accepted on June 18, 2007. A Public Notice of Application was published on July 25, 2007 and August 1, 2007 in the Columbia Basin Herald.

The effective date of this permit is August 20, 2007 and will remain in force for up to five years or until a new permit is issued for your facility.

Under the Model Toxics Control Act, now codified as RCW 90.48.465, Ecology is required to recover the cost of the Water Quality Permit Program. Ecology has adopted a regulation (Chapter 173-224 WAC) establishing annual permit fees for all municipal/domestic and industrial wastewater discharge permit holders. Your Temporary Permit is subject to this fee commencing on its effective date. You will be notified of the amount of the fee, payment schedules, and other details in a separate mailing from the Ecology Fee Unit.
